NCAA HISTORY
Notre Dame has competed in 26 NCAA Championships. Their streak of 24 straight appearances came to an end in March of 2021. It was the fourth longest active streak in the country and fifth best all-time.

The lrish are 67-24 all-time in the NCAA Tournament, as their 67 wins rank fourth all-time.

Notre Dame joins Louisiana Tech and USC with two NCAA titles behind UConn (11), Tennessee (8), Baylor (3) and Stanford (3).

Notre Dame is one of three schools (Tennessee \& UConn) to reach seven NCAA Title games. Their nine Final Four appearances are the fifth-most of any school behind UConn (19), Tennessee (18), Stanford (14) and La Tech (10).

The Irish have reached 10 Elite Eights. In fact, Notre Dame and UConn are the only teams to reach the Elite

Eight eight times over the last 11 tournaments. Yet, the Irish have been more successful than any other regular-ly-appearing school at that stage, as their .900 winning percentage $(9-1)$ is the best of any program to play in at least five Elite Eights.

Enter Ivey, who can be linked to all nine of Notre Dame's Final Fours - two as a player and seven as an assistant coach. All-in-all, lvey spent 17 combined years on campus before receiving the head coaching job.

In fact, Notre Dame's last decade of dominance (201019) had Ivey's handprints written all over it. No other program had produced more trips to the national title game (six) in that span. Plus, the Irish posted the third

most wins (339) during that span as well. That decade also consisted of 14 conference championships (eight regular-season plus six tournament titles split between the BIG EAST and ACC), seven Final Fours and a 2018 national championship.

## TRAILBLAZER

When Niele Ivey accepted the assistant coaching position with the Memphis Grizzlies, she became 1-of-9 active female coaches in the NBA. Over the course of the season, Ivey helped develop a young team, with a new coaching staff, into a playoff contender. Ivey worked with several different position groups with the Grizzlies, but primarily with standout guards Jarien Jackson and Ja Morant, as the latter won 2020 NBA Rookie of the Year honors.

When Ivey accepted the head coaching position at Notre Dame, she then became the first black female head coach of any sport in the history of the school.

## ACC ROOKIE OF THE YEAR, MADDY WESTBELD

The ACC Head Coaches voted Maddy Westbeld as their Rookie of the Year winner. Westbeld entered an elite Notre Dame club, becoming just the sixth player in program history to win a conference's Rookie of the Year award. She also is the second to do so in the ACC, joining Briana Turner who accomplished the feat in 2015.

Westbeld's awards haul didn't stop there. Notre Dame's leading scorer and rebounder also collected First Team All-ACC honors as voted upon by the Blue-Ribbon media panel and a Second-Team nod from the Head Coaches Panel. Westbeld also naturally landed on the ACC All-Freshman list.

She was not only the most complete freshman in the ACC this past season, but also one of the most complete in the entire country. Here's the stats to back it up:

- ACC Freshmen-only stat rankings: 1st in Scoring, 2nd in Rebounding, 2nd in Steals, 4th in Assists \& 4th in Blocks. She was the only freshman in the league to rank in the top-four in all above-mentioned categories. - Maddy was the only freshman in the country who averaged at least 15 points, 7.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists \& 1.4 steals. Overall, she was just 1-of-8 Division-I players. - Ranked 4th in the country among freshmen in the Points+Rebounds+Assists/Game category with 25.5 topped ACC freshmen.
- Her 15.2 ppg led all ACC rookies and ranked 10th overall in the league. Nationally, her scoring average ranked 11th among all Division I freshmen.
"She's been the most dominant player I've seen coming in as a freshman, outside of Arike and Skylar. She has a college body. Her work ethic is incredible. I knew she would make an immediate impact with this team." - Coach Ivey


## IMMEDIATEIMPACT- OLIVIA MILES

Notre Dame received a major midseason pick-me-up in star point guard Olivia Miles, who became the program's first ever early enrollee. Miles arrived on campus on Jan. 18 and partook in a week of quarantine. Once she was cleared, she started practicing with the team on Jan. 27. She had three practices under her belt heading into Syracuse, where she made an immediate impact.

Miles brought a new look and swagger to the Irish offense. The freshman ended the season on a five-game double-digit scoring streak, totaling 52 points ( 10.4 ppg ) in that span. Her 9.3 ppg on her short season ranked as the 4th best on the squad, while her 3.5 apg took the top mark.

More impressive was the fact that the 18 -year old was thrown into the fire -- four out of her six games were
against top-5 seeds in the ACC tournament.
Miles made up one-half of Coach lvey's top-five nationally ranked recruiting class that also featured guard Sonia Citron. Miles was ranked the No. 8 prospect overall by ESPN and the No. 2 point guard.

## POST-COVID PAUSE STATS

The future certainly looks bright because the two best players coming out of the team's Covid-pause were Westbeld and Miles. Over the last four games, Westbeld nearly averaged a double-double with 16.8 ppg and 9.5 rpg . The Ohio native shot 56.8 percent from the field and converted 14-of-15 from the free-throw line. Miles was the lone other player in double figures with 10.5 ppg , to go with her 4.8 apg . In fact, the duo not only boasted the top two scoring averages, but the top two assist totals as well, with Miles leading with 19, followed by nine from Westbeld.

## NEW RECORD HOLDER

Destinee Walker was the definition of consistentcy from the free-throw line this past season, and as a result, we have new single-season free-throw percentage record holder.

Walker shot 90.2 percent from the charity stripe, which ranked 1st the ACC and 6th in the country. She converted 55-of-61 attempts. She once had built a streak of 27 consecutive made free-throws, which came to an end against Florida State on Feb. 25.

Destinee topped the record that was held by Kayla McBride, who shot 90.0 percent ( 90 -of- 100 ) in the 2012-13 season (minimum of 2.0 made per game).

## WHERE MADDY RANKED AMONG ND FRESHMEN

We talked about where Maddy ranked among the top freshmen in the country, but what about Notre Dame all-time?

Westbeld's 15.2 ppg scoring average ranked in the top-
three all-time behind Shari Matvey (17.6 in 1979-80) and Beth Morgan (17.9 in 1993-94). Furthermore, her 7.9 rpg tied Brianna Turner for fourth.

## APPROACHING MILESTONE: 700

When it comes to the Mabrey family, that's a whole lot of buckets. Queens of three some might say. Marina graduated in 2019 as the program's all-time career made three-pointer leader, draining a total of 274. Michaela converted a career total of 228, while Dara now boasts 195. All-in-all, the Mabreys have totaled a whopping 697 splash-downs.

## TURN THE THREE AROUND

At the end of the 2019-20 season, the lrish ranked dead last in the ACC in three-point shooting percentage (.271). Fast forward to now and the Irish recorded quite the renaissance from beyond the arc, primarily thanks to the quartet of Mabrey, Brunelle, Westbeld and Walker. In fact, the lrish converted 35.5 percent from three, which not only ranked as the 4th best in the ACC, but also 41st in the country.

Dara Mabrey led the ACC in three-point shooting percentage for a portion of the season, but ultimately finished 5th with her 38.5 percent. That number also ranks 61st in the nation.

Westbeld ultimately led the team in three-point shooting percentage with her 38.8 percent. Walker followed right behind at 38.5 percent, while Brunelle clocked in at 38.3 percent.

## HERE COME THE IRISH -- MAYA DODSON

On Feb. 2, Coach lvey tweeted, best day of 2021 by far. Shortly after the program announced the addition of Stanford transfer Maya Dodson, who will be eligible to play for the 2021-22 season.

The 6-3 forward from Alpharetta, Georgia, had previously opted out of her senior season at Stanford. In just three years with the Cardinal, Dodson already worked herself into the program's all-time top-10 in career blocks (78) and career field goal percentage (.497).
"I am thrilled to welcome Maya Dodson to our Notre Dame family," Karen \& Kevin Keyes Family Notre Dame Head Coach Niele Ivey stated. "She is a program changer and the perfect fit for the culture that I am cultivating. She is highly driven with an incredible skillset and work ethic. She brings great experience and leadership to a very young and talented core. I can't wait to get to work with her!"

## SAM'S SHOOTING IMPROVEMENT

Now the stats show that Brunelle certainly didn't take as many shots as she did last year, but they do show that her accuracy vastly improved. Brunelle went from averaging 13.2 shot attempts/game to 7.4 this year.

However, her percentages are way up in year two.
She went from shooting 31.5 percent from three as a
freshman to 38.3 percent this year. She also went from 39.7 percent overall to 48.4 percent, which ranked 3rd on the team behind Vaughn and Miles.

## STAT-SHEET STUFEER ANAYA

Anaya produced three 5-5-5 'Stat-Sheet Stuffer' games this season. A stat-sheet stuffer is when you get five or more in three major stat categories.

Due to her success to pad the stats, Peoples was the only player in the ACC to average at least nine points, six rebounds, 1.5 steals and two assists.

In addition, Peoples owned two double-doubles on the year and flirted with three others, coming either one rebound or one point short.

## FINAL RESUME

Notre Dame's 10-10 record resulted in a NET ranking of 56. Their average opponent NET ranking was 13. The Irish were 4-6 against NET top-50 opposition. As a result, come NCAA Selection Monday, the Irish were listed in the First Four Out category and their 24-year NCAA Tournament streak concluded.

## IIGHT GAMES AND 4TH QUARTER RIDES

The lrish went on a wild ride over the first half of the ACC season. The Irish held substantial leads in almost every single game in January, but went 4-3 in that month.

At Boston College, Notre Dame was up 60-48 with 3:29
remaining, but lost 64-61.
At North Carolina, Notre Dame was up 70-63 with 4:36 left, but dropped a 78-73 decision. The Tar Heels outscored the Irish 24-15 in the fourth.

At Syracuse, the Irish once held a 15-point lead and were up $65-58$ heading into the fourth. Then the Orange outscored the lrish 23-4 in the fourth to take it 81-69.

Now, the Irish did hold on to some fourth quarter leads during their three-game win streak, but still saw double-digit leads shrink to a one-possession game.

ND was up 67-53 with 7:00 on the clock before Wake Forest trimmed it to one possession. ND went on for the 79-72 win.

At Virginia Tech, the Irish built a lead as large as 21, before the Hokies cut it to 61-58 with 19.5 seconds left. ND then surged ahead for the 65-60 victory.

Later on in late February, the Irish boasted an 18-point lead in the fourth against Florida State, until the Seminoles produced a late flurry to make it a six-point game. The Irish held on for the 72-64 victory.

## WESTBELD 2X ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

So nice, she did it twice. Westbeld became the first player in the league this season to win either ACC Rookie or Player of the Week twice. Maddy first received the Rookie nod on Dec. 7 after averaging 20.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals against No. 24 Michigan and IUPUI. She scored 12 of her 22 points in the 4th quarter against IUPUI, spearheading the Irish to victory. In the win vs the Jags, Maddy led the Irish in points, rebounds and assists - the last time an Irish player achieved that - Jackie Young vs Syracuse on March 9, 2019.

The second time around on Jan. 3, Maddy averaged 13 points and 6 rebounds in wins over Miami \& Georgia Tech.

## MABREY MAGIC

Dara went off for a career high 34 points in the season opener - marking the most prolific Irish debut in history. She now owns family bragging rights, topping both the career highs of her two sisters. Dara went 7-of-14 from three, tying for the second most three-pointers in a single game.

## SISTER, SISTER ... SISTER

With Dara donning an Irish uniform this season, she completed the Mabrey lineage at Notre Dame, following in the footsteps of her older sisters, Michaela and Marina. Only one other Division I team has had three sisters come through the same program - Washington State, who had three all on the same team the past two

## GUARD UNIVERSITY WELCOMING NEW MEMBERS

First year at the helm and Coach Ivey landed a top-5 recruiting class in Sonia Citron and Olivia Miles. Miles ranked No. 8 overall in her class and the second ranked point guard. Miles attends Blair Academy, where last season she averaged 13.6 points, 8.1 rebounds and 7.6 assists, on her way to a Prep A State Championship in 2020.

Citron ranked No. 16 overall in her class and sixth at her position. Citron is coming off of a banner year at The Ursuline School, where she led the Koalas to a 24-0 record and first Section Ititle since 2003. Citron was named the 2020 New York State Gatorade Player of the Year after averaging 23.8 points, 10.4 rebounds, 3.5 steals and 4.3 assists.

Both Miles \& Citron have history as teammates, winning a gold medal together with the U16 USA National Team in 2019 in Chile. Citron was named to the All-Tournament Team. They've also played AAU ball together with the Philadelphia Belles.

## WELCOME BACK ABBY

It's been a long road back for Abby Prohaska, who took a medical redshirt last season after being diagnosed with bilateral pulmonary embolism in 0ctober. In fact it was 599 total days between the 2019 NCAA title game against Baylor and the season opener.
"When I first found out, my heart dropped into my stomach and didn't have any words. I was surrounded by my medical staff and team who comforted me. I just remembered there's more to life than basketball and Coach McGraw made sure that my health was the No. 1 priority. She made me believe I could get over this. I am truly blessed to play and it's an opportunity I will take advantage of."

Prohaska played a pivotal role off the bench for the 2019 NCAA runner-up squad. In fact, she was the spark in the second half rally over Stanford in the Elite Eight.

Against Miami (OH), Prohaska recorded the first dou-ble-digit scoring effort of her career with 10 points.

- 1-of-3 ND freshmen all-tie to earn WBCA All-America Regional Finalist honors, joining Turner \& Diggins.
- ACC Freshmen Rankings: 1st in Scoring, 2nd in Rebounding, 2nd in Steals, 4th in Assists \& 4th in Blocks. She was the only freshman in the league to rank in the top-four in all above-mentioned categories.
