- During league play, Notre Dame led the BIG EAST in batting avg. (.385), slugging pct. (636), on-base pct. (.459), runs (162), hits (204) and RBI (145).
- The Irish have won 14 of their last 15 contests and 27 of the last 29 affairs.
- Notre Dame has posted respective winning streaks of nine, six and a pair of 14-game jaunts on the season.
- After winning the BIG EAST Conference regular season crown, Notre Dame was eliminated from the league tournament following a 6-0 semifinal loss to host Louisville.
