Notre Dame topped Indiana 2-1 on Wednesday ... senior forward Jeb Brovsky and junior midfielder Adam Mena netted goals in the win ... senior forward Steven Perry leads Notre Dame in goals (5) and points (12) this season ... the Irish are averaging 1.30 goals per game, while allowing 0.70 per contest ... sophomore midfielder Dillon Powers has a team-best three assists ... fifth-year senior goalkeeper Philip Tuttle, who is returning from a knee injury suffered in the summer, has started the past three matches ... Tuttle has a 2-0-1 record with a 0.93 goals-against average and a .769 save percentage ... junior Will Walsh has made seven starts in goal and boasts a 3-2-2 record with four shutouts ... Saturday will be the 15th meeting between Notre Dame and West Virginia ... the Fighting Irish lead the series 8-5-1 ... the Mountaineers topped the Irish 1-0 last season at Notre Dame ... the Irish are 3-4-0 all-time at West Virginia ... in the last meeting in Morgantown, Notre Dame came away with a 1-0 triumph during the 2008 season ... the last three encounters have been 1-0 decisions with the Fighting Irish taking two of those matches ... six of the last seven meetings in the series have been decided by one goal, while the other was a tie ... the Fighting Irish hold a 19-10 scoring edge in the series ... Notre Dame has shut out West Virginia on eight occasions.

SCOUTING THE MOUNTAINEERS ...

West Virginia will carry a 5-3-2 record into Saturday's clash with the Irish ... the Mountaineers are 1-1 in BIG EAST play following a win over DePaul (5-0) and a loss to Georgetown (1-0) ... West Virginia is 4-1 at home with the setback coming against Monmouth (1-0 in doubleovertime) ... the Mountaineers are averaging 1.60 goals per game, while allowing 0.90 per contest ... sophomore forward Moeryhan Doue leads the team in goals (5) and points (12) ... fellow sophomore forward Abel Sebele has a team-best five assists ... senior Zach Johnson has played every minute in goal and carries a 0.84 goals-against average and a .763 save percentage with three shutouts ... THE LAST TIME ...

West Virginia topped Notre Dame 1-0 last season at Alumni Stadium ... the lone goal was an Alex Silva tally in the 48th minute ... the Fighting Irish out shot the Mountaineers 18-3 and Notre Dame also had 15 corner kicks compared to three for West Virginia ... Philip Tuttle played all 90 minutes in goal for the Irish and made one save ... West Virginia's Zach Johnson made eight stops, while the Mountaineers also had three team saves.

NOTRE DAME IN BIG EAST PLAY ...

Notre Dame owns an overall record of 93-53-17 (.623) in BIG EAST regular-season play since joining the conference in 1995 ... the Irish have posted nine straight winning seasons within the conference, including last season's 8-3-0 mark ... the eight wins in BIG EAST play in 2009 tied for the most ever for the Fighting Irish ... Notre Dame also won eight BIG EAST matches in 2004 (8-1-1) and 2006 (8-3) ... the Irish have three regular-season BIG EAST titles ... Notre Dame won the championship outright in 2004 and 2008 (Blue Division) and shared the Blue Division trophy with Connecticut in 2007 ... the Fighting Irish captured BIG EAST tournament crowns in 1996 and 2003.

CLARK IN THE CONFERENCE ...

Head coach Bobby Clark has steered the Irish to a winning record within BIG EAST Conference play during all nine of his seasons at Notre Dame ... Clark has a 65-22-10 (.722) BIG EAST mark during his Notre Dame tenure, which began in 2001 ... his Irish teams have captured three regular-season BIG EAST titles and two BIG EAST tournament championships.

OFF TO A GOOD START ...

Notre Dame has opened BIG EAST play 2-0 for the first time since the 2007 campaign ... that season, the Irish finished with a 7-0-4 record in the league to tie Connecticut for the Blue Division crown ... the Fighting Irish currently are in first place in the league's Blue Division.

QUOTING CLARK ...

Junior midfielder **Adam Mena** scored the game winner in the 80th minute in Notre Dame's 2-1 triumph at Indiana on Wednesday ... it was Mena's first goal of the season and his first career gamewinning tally.

PERRY PERFORMING ...

Senior forward **Steven Perry** has a team-best five goals this season ... that is a single-season careerhigh total and it currently ranks him in a tie for second among all BIG EAST players ... Perry saw his three-game goal streak come to an end against Indiana, but he dished out a single-game careerbest two assists against the Hoosiers ... the goal streak began with the lone tally (70th minute) in a 1-0 win over St. John's ... he then deposited the equalizer in the 79th minute in a 1-1 draw with Northwestern ... Perry put home the game winner in the 85th minute in a 2-1 triumph of Providence ... earlier this season, Perry tallied a career-high two goals in a 2-0 victory over Drake.
