Notre Dame leads the all-time series with Georgetown 13-1-0 (82-7 scoring margin), including a 3-0 win this season on Oct. 12 at Alumni Field (18-1 ND shot edge; also 9-1 shots on goal, 3-1 in corner kicks) ... **Brittany Bock** (2G-1A) led the ND offense in that game while **Courtney Rosen** had her first goal of the season ... both teams returned seven starters from the 2006 season but ND lost twice as many total letterwinners (8-4) ... when looking at common 2007 opponents (full list at left), ND won this season at Louisville (1-0), beat Villanova in a 5-0 home games and twice topped Rutgers (3-1 at RU, 2-0 at ND in quarterfinals), while GU lost at home to UL (1-0/OT), lost at home to VU (1-0) and dropped a 2-1 game at RU ... ND has scored 10 more goals than GU this season (50-40) but the Hoyas have allowed one fewer goal (19-20) ... ND is averaging five more shots per game than GU (18-13) but the Hoyas have been a bit more accurate (.149 shot pct., to ND's .146) ... GU has a 7-5 edge on ND in corner kicks/gm ... GU (6-4) has played twice as many 1-goal games this season (ND is 2-3) but the Irish have played four overtime games (GU 1) and ND has seven wins by margins of 3-plus goals (GU has 3) ... GU has no double-digit goalscorers (ND has 2) but four Hoyas players have 5-plus goals (ND 3) ... GU has more seniors (8, to ND's 5) ... ND is 28-2-0 all-time in the BIG EAST Tournament while GU is 2-4-0 ... see full pre-tournament notes (to be posted later on und.com) for additional info. on the upcoming ND-GU game.
