Hat Trick History

Notre Dame players have combined to score 55 hat tricks in 19 seasons, including at least one every year from 1988-2000. Jenny Heft had three hat tricks in 1998 to bring her career total to five, tying Monica Gerardo and Rosella Guerrero for most in ND history. Heft then broke the record with a hat trick in 1999 versus Georgetown. Amy Warner in 2000 set the record for earliest hat trick by a Notre Dame freshman, based on date (Sept. 3, vs. Providence), while Guerrero was the only Irish freshman to notch a hat trick in the season opener (vs. #5 North Carolina State, 1992) – with **Kerri Hanks** besting Wagner and matching Guerrero's feat after her hat trick in the 2005 opener vs. UNH (Aug. 26). 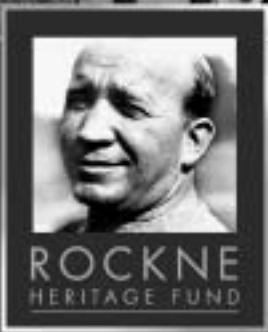
