Did You Know...

- we competed** in our first NCAA Lacrosse Final Four in 2001.
- we had** our first freshman All-American in 2003 (Pat Walsh, honorable mention).
- we have** participated in the NCAA tournament 10 times since 1990 (a feat matched by only six other Division I schools) and have advanced to the quarterfinals three times since 1995.
- we have** a total of 50 years of coaching experience at the college and pro level, including 32 years of head-coaching experience.
- we are** the No. 1 school in the nation in student-athlete graduation rate, according to the 2003 NCAA annual report. **EVERY** senior lacrosse player, since the program attained varsity status in 1981, has graduated.
- our record** over the last 12 years (109-54, .669) is among the top 10 marks in Division I.
- we offer,** during Notre Dame's First Year of Studies, a broad range of curriculum and a special advisement program which includes free tutoring and group study sessions, allowing 98% of freshman students to complete their first year successfully.
- we have** had 22 All-Americans (including at least one in each of the last 11 seasons) and placed 18 seniors in the North/South All-Star Game in the last 10 years. We also have had five NSCAA Scholar All-Americans in the last seven years.
- we have** been ranked in the top 20 the past 10 seasons with top 10 finishes in 1996, 1997, 2000 and 2001.
- we offer** over 50 undergraduate majors, along with numerous secondary majors and concentrations, in four colleges: the Colleges of Arts and Letters, Business Administration, Engineering and Science.
- our home** record over the past 11 years is 57-16 with games played in the lighted 5,000-seat Moose Krause Stadium.
- we are** supported by the Office of Academic Services for Student-Athletes, members of which meet regularly with all athletes to monitor their academic progress, arrange free tutoring, and offer academic and career counseling.
- our home** away from home, the Loftus Sports Center, is among the best indoor training facilities in the country, equipped with a 9,000 sq. foot weight room and a 120-yard prestige field turf playing surface, allowing us to play any day of the year under ideal conditions.
- we rank** among the top 20 universities in recent college surveys done by: U.S. News and World Report, Barron's Top 50: An Insider's Look at America's Best Colleges and Money Magazine, among others.
- only ND** and Stanford University have consistently ranked in both U.S. News and World Report's Top 20 and in the top 20 of the Sears/NACDA Director's Cup, an award based on success in all sports competing at the varsity level among Division I schools.
- we are** one of only five schools to have finished 13th or higher in each of the last three Sears/NACDA Director's Cup all-sports competitions.
- we completed** our 1995 season with a 10-day tour of Ireland, and our 2001 season with a 10-day tour of England and Ireland.
