ND History in Event: Notre Dame won its second straight BIG EAST title in 2006. The Irish captured four event titles in 2006, which matched their total from the 2005 championship, the program's first-ever BIG EAST title. Notre Dame also registered 20 all-BIG EAST performances last season. In all, 13 Irish student-athletes garnered all-conference accolades. In order to gain all-BIG EAST honors, a swimmer or diver must place in the top three spots of his or her event.

ND History in Event: Notre Dame has consistently sent divers to this meet and Michael Bulfin became the first one to advance to the NCAA Championships when he did so in 2006. Bulfin placed fourth in the three-meter competition to lock up a spot in the NCAA meet. He also registered a ninth-place showing off of the one-meter board. Sam Stoner placed 10th in the one-meter and 17th in the three-meter during the 2006 event.

ND History in Event: Notre Dame has had three student-athletes qualify for this meet: diver Bob Ebel in 1975, swimmer Tim Kegelman in 2005 and diver Michael Bulfin in 2006. Ebel placed 77th off the three-meter board. Kegelman finished 37th in the 200-yard fly (1:52.78) and 39th in the 200-yard IM (1:50.30). He was disqualified for an illegal turn in the 100-yard fly. Bulfin placed 18th in the prelims of the three-meter competition and 27th in the one-meter prelims. Notre Dame has yet to register a point in the meet.
