COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

503	With Notre Dame's 3-2 win over Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament championship game last season, head coach Jeff Jackson recorded his 500th career win, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and 14 seasons at Notre Dame. He now has 503 career wins, which ranks second among active NCAA DI head coaches.
51	Over the 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons, Notre Dame totaled 51 wins to rank fourth in the NCAA and first in the Big Ten over in that time span: 1. Minnesota State (61); 2. St. Cloud State (55); 3. Minnesota Duluth (54); 4. Notre Dame (51) ; 5. Northeastern (50); 6. Clarkson (49); 7. Bowling Green (48) and Providence (48).
13	Thirteen sets of brothers have suited up for the Irish, including current sets of brothers Cal and Cam Burke and Matt and Alex Steeves .
8	With the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history, each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
8	Eight former Fighting Irish players have appeared on NHL rosters so far this season, including: Anders Bjork (Boston Bruins), Ian Cole (Colorado Avalanche), Dennis Gilbert (Chicago Blackhawks), Vinnie Hinostroza (Arizona Coyotes), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New Jersey Devils), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins/IR) and Riley Sheahan (Edmonton Oilers).
6	With freshman Trevor Janicke joining the program, six father-son combinations have played for the Irish including Trevor and his father, Curtis '93 , as well as sophomore Graham Slaggert and his father/Associate Head Coach Andy Slaggert '89 .
4	Notre Dame has an active four-year NCAA tournament appearance streak, including Frozen Four appearances in 2017 and 2018, which is the longest streak in program history and is the fourth-longest active streak in the NCAA (the Irish have also appeared in seven of the last 10 NCAA Tournaments).
4	All four of Notre Dame's top goal scorers from last season return for the 2019-20 campaign including Cal Burke (12), Michael Graham (12), Colin Theisen (11) and Cam Morrison (11).
3	Cam Morrison has three career overtime goals, which is tied for the active lead across the NCAA. Two of his three overtime winners have come in postseason play, clinching the 2018 Big Ten Tournament championship with a goal against Ohio State and sending the Irish to the 2019 NCAA Northeast Regional Final with the OT winner versus Clarkson.
2.5	Mike O'Leary enters the weekend tied for the NCAA lead with a 2.50 assists per game average (tied with Nick Halloran of Colorado College).

FOR STARTERS

- The No. 5/4 Notre Dame Fighting Irish return to action with a weekend home series against Lake Superior State University.
- Notre Dame, which was off last weekend, swept its season-opening series against Air Force (Oct. 11 & 14), coming back to defeat the Falcons 4-3 in game one and then winning game two by a score of 6-1.
- Freshman Ryan Bischel made both starts for the Irish, posting a 2.00 goals against average and a .932 save percentage in the weekend sweep.
- With five assists in the two wins, senior Mike O'Leary leads the team in points, while Colin Theisen (3-1-4) and Cal Burke (2-2-4) each have four points.
- The Irish penalty kill was a perfect 5-for-5 in the series, while Notre Dame finished 2-for-7 on the power play.
- Lake Superior enters the series after being swept by Big Ten foe Michigan by scores of 4-0 and 4-3 (Oct. 18-19).
- The Lakers opened the year by sweeping Merrimack at home and then were swept at home by currently top-ranked Denver.
- Notre Dame is coming off a program-best fourth consecutive trip to the NCAA tournament in 2018-19 and advanced to a regional final for the third consecutive season (won regional final games in 2017 and 2018 to advance to the Frozen Four).
- The Irish also won the Big Ten Tournament Championship for a second consecutive season in 2019.

LAKE STATE SERIES CONNECTIONS

- In six years as the head coach at Lake Superior State (1990-96), Jeff Jackson's teams won NCAA titles in 1992 and 1994 and also advanced to the finals in 1993.
- His teams also won two CCHA regular-season championships (1991 and 1996) and four CCHA Mason Cup trophies (1991, 1992, 1993 and 1995).
- Jackson got his start in college hockey as an assistant coach at Lake Superior State in 1986 where he served four years under Frank Anzalone, helping guide the Lakers to one CCHA championship and the 1988 NCAA title.
- Current Lake State assistant coach Zack Cisek served as Notre Dame's volunteer assistant coach for the 2017-18 season.

THE NOTRE DAME - LAKE STATE SERIES

- Notre Dame and Lake Superior State have met 69 times but not since playing three times during the 2014-15 season, including twice at the Compton family Ice Arena when the Irish swept the Lakers by scores of 5-3 and 5-1.
- The teams then met for a third time in 2014-15 when they played in the championship game of the Florida College Hockey Classic in Estero, Florida with the Lakers scoring the game winner with less than a minute after Notre Dame tied the game at 1-1 late in the third period.
- Overall, the Irish lead the series 36-26-7, including a 22-9-4 mark at home (6-0-0 at the Compton Family Ice Arena).
- Notre Dame has an active seven-game home winning streak against the Lakers and is 8-2-0 in the last 10 meetings dating back to the 2010-11 season.
- Jackson is 20-4-4 all-time against the Lakers (and at Notre Dame).

THREE GOALS AND COUNTING

- Over the past two seasons, the Irish are now 19-0-1 when scoring at least three goals.
- In 2018-19, Notre Dame went 17-0-1 when scoring three or more goals.
- The lone tie came to open the season on Oct. 12 against Mercyhurst in the Ice Breaker - a game that ended knotted at 6-6 before Notre Dame won the shootout to advance to the championship game.

BIG PRESEASON HONORS

- Cale Morris was named a unanimous Preseason All-Big Ten First Team selection and Cal Burke was tabbed as an Honorable Mention honoree (Sept. 30).
- The Fighting Irish were picked to finish second in the Big Ten preseason coaches' poll:

BURKE EARNS CAPTAINCY

- Senior Cal Burke was named the team captain for 2019-20, while his classmates Tory Dello and Cale Morris will take on alternate captain roles.
- Burke served as an alternate captain as a junior.
- Dello and Morris will each be donning a letter for the first time in their Irish careers.
- Morris becomes the second goaltender under Jackson to wear a letter following Cal Petersen, who served as the team's captain for the 2016-17 season.

IRISH IN THE NHL

- Eight former Notre Dame players have made NHL rosters so far this season, including: Anders Bjork (Boston Bruins), Ian Cole (Colorado Avalanche), Vinnie Hinostroza (Arizona Coyotes), Anders Lee (New York Islanders), Kyle Palmieri (New Jersey Devils), Bryan Rust (Pittsburgh Penguins/IR) and Riley Sheahan (Edmonton Oilers).
- Lee eclipsed the 50-point mark for the third consecutive season in 2018-19 while serving as captain for the New York Islanders.
- Lee led the Islanders with 28 goals while adding 23 assists in 82 contests and after the season, the Edina, Minnesota, native signed a seven-year, \$49 million contract to stay in New York.
- A 2019 NHL All-Star, Palmieri led the New Jersey Devils with 50 points (27G, 23A) in 74 contests.
- Palmieri is one of three Notre Dame hockey players to be selected in the first round of

the NHL Draft, joining Cole and Sheahan.

- Rust, a two-time Stanley Cup Champion with the Pittsburgh Penguins, netted a career-high 18 goals last season while collecting 35 points in 72 games.
- Cole is set to embark on his second season with the Colorado Avalanche after posting 15 points (2G, 13A) in 71 games last season.
- Hinostroza is in his second season with the Arizona Coyotes after posting career-highs in goals (16), assists (23) and points (39) a season ago.
- Sheahan is playing his first season with the Edmonton Oilers in what will be his ninth NHL season.
- In total, 35 former Irish players have seen ice time in the NHL, 20 of whom played at Notre Dame under current head coach Jeff Jackson.

PRO IRISH WEARING THE "C"

- While Cal Burke has been named the captain for Notre Dame this season, Irish alumni in the professional ranks are also picking up the honor and responsibility of wearing the "C" in 2019-20.
- Anders Lee, who captained the Irish in 2012-13, is in his second season serving as captain of the New York Islanders.
- Steven Fogarty, who was a two-year captain at Notre Dame in 2014-15 and 2015-16, was named the captain of the Hartford Wolfpack (AHL) to start the 2019-20 season.
- Sam Herr, an alternate captain with the Irish in 2015-16, was named the Nottingham Panthers' (EIHL) for the 2019-20 season.
- Bo Brauer, a 2018 Notre Dame graduate, was named captain of the Worcester Railers (ECHL) to start the 2019-20 season as well.

FAMILY TIES

- The 2019-20 Notre Dame roster features two sets of brothers, Cal and Cam Burke and Matt and Alex Steeves.
- They are the 12th and 13th sets of brothers to skate together at Notre Dame and the first since Ben (2008-11) and Andy Ryan (2012-16).
- Junior goaltender Dylan St. Cyr is the son of Son of Gerry St. Cyr, who played five seasons of professional hockey including the AHL's New Haven Senators and Manon Rheaume, who played goaltender for Canada at the 1998 Olympic Winter Games and in several world championships and who was the first woman to appear in an NHL pre-season game when she skated for the Tampa Bay Lightning in 1992.
- Sophomore forward and South Bend native, Graham Slaggert, joins his father Andy Slaggert who serves as Associate Head Coach and former star for the Irish.
- The Slaggerts were the fifth father-son duo to suit up for Notre Dame.
- Sophomore forward Jake Pivonka is the son of Czech Republic native and former NHL player Michael Pivonka who played over 800 games with the Washington Capitals (1986-99).
- Freshman forward Trevor Janicke is the son of Curtis Janicke, who played for the Irish from 1989-93, appearing in 125 games while scoring 46 goals and adding 98 assists 144 points.
- Trevor and Curtis are now the sixth father-son duo to play for the Irish.
- Freshman forward Solag Bakich is the son of Huntley Bakich, who was a linebacker for the Fighting Irish football team during the Lou Holtz era.

**HEAD COACH
JEFF JACKSON**



- The 2019-20 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson's 15th season behind the Irish bench.
- The highly regarded Jackson now has over 30 years of coaching experience and is coming off back-to-back Big Ten championship seasons while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 14 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is the only coach to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 15 seasons.
- Notre Dame's Jeff Jackson era began in 2005 when the University searched for a coach who could move the program among the elite hockey schools in the country.
- Jackson's Notre Dame teams have made 10 trips to the NCAA Championship (2007-09, 2011, 2013-14, 2016-19), advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 14-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation's top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006-07 and 2008-09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team's first season in the Big Ten (2017-18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018-19).
- Jackson's success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson's arrival, the Irish have had 35 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections. In that same span, 24 players from USA Hockey's National Team

- During Jackson's tenure, the Irish have had eight players garner All-America honors — Bobby Nardella in 2019, Cale Morris in 2018, Anders Bjork in 2017, Robbie Russo in 2015, Anders Lee in 2013, Ian Cole and Erik Condra in 2009 and David Brown in 2007. In addition, 19 of Jackson's Notre Dame players have gone on to play in the NHL.
- Jackson entered the 2019-20 season with a 20-year collegiate record of 501-243-82 for a .656 winning percentage, the second-highest winning percentage among all active coaches with five years or more in Division I (entering 2019-20).
- To start the 2019-20 season, Jackson's 501 career wins ranked tied for 12th all-time in Division I and second among active coaches (entering 2019-20).
