IRISH ITEMS - BY THE NUMBERS

1	There is only one player in the country shooting .500 from the field, .500 from 3FG range (1.5 3FGM/G) and averaging 15.0 ppg - senior Dane Goodwin .
2	Notre Dame is the only major conference team with two shooters in the nation's top five in 3FG% - Dane Goodwin (2nd, .500) and senior Nate Laszewski (5th, .474).
5	With 997 career points, Nate Laszewski is closing in on 1,000 career points. When he reaches that milestone, Notre Dame will become the first team in the nation this season to have five 1,000 career point scorers on its roster - Paul Atkinson Jr., Dane Goodwin, Prentiss Hubb, Trey Wertz and Laszewski.
6.2	Assist/turnover ratio for senior Prentiss Hubb in ACC play this year - the best by far for any league player.
7	Notre Dame will confer an NCAA Division I men's basketball-best seven degrees in the spring of 2022 - undergraduate degrees to R. Carmody, D. Goodwin, P. Hubb, N. Laszewski, C. Ryan and T. Wertz, along with a graduate degree to P. Atkinson Jr.
10	Notre Dame has won 10 straight games in Purcell Pavilion dating back to last season, which includes wins over No. 11/11 Florida State last March, a 66-62 win over No. 10/12 Kentucky on December 11 and a five- point win over North Carolina on Jan. 5.
10	Notre Dame is 10-0 in 2021-22 when they connect on 10-or-more 3FGs. In the team's run of 10 wins in their last 11 games, the Irish have posted 10-or-more 3FGs eight times.
20	Career-best streak of double-digit scoring games for Dane Goodwin — all 20 games this season. Goodwin lead the Irish at 15.4 ppg.
21	First-half points scored by senior Cormac Ryan against Duke last season. He eventually finished the contest with a career-high 28 points in Notre Dame 93-89 victory.
15.0	Points-per-game average for freshman Blake Wesley , which is the third-best average in the ACC and fifth-best among major conference true freshman (see page 6 for more details).

GAME TRENDS

In 2021-22 the Notre Dame is:

- 11-0 when they shoot better than their opponent.
- 10-0 when they make 10-or-more three-point field goals.
- 9-0 at Purcell Pavilion.
- 7-1 when a Notre Dame player scores 20-or-more points.

The University of Notre Dame men's basketball (14-6, 7-2) puts their undefeated record at Purcell Pavilion on the line Monday night against nationally-ranked Duke (17-3, 8-2) on ESPN's Big Monday (7 p.m. ET). The Irish have won 11 of their last 13 games and face back-

to-back games against Duke (tied for 2nd in the ACC) and Miami (first place in the league) over a three-day stretch.

NOTRE DAME TRUE FRESHMAN COMPARISONS

Notre Dame freshman Blake Wesley, who has earned two ACC Freshman of the Week awards, is starting to establish himself as one of the best freshmen to ever don an Irish uniform. On pace to score score well over 300 points this season (he has 299 as of January 30) — Wesley will be just the 13th true freshman in Notre Dame history to log over 300 points.

The 12 previous freshmen to eclipse 300 points are Adrian Dantely, Rich Branning, Kelly Tripucka, David Rivers, LaPhonso Ellis, Pat Garrity, Troy Murphy, David Graves, Matt Carroll, Chris Thomas, Torin Francis and Luke Harangody (the final four on this list all doing so for Mike Brey).

MIKE BREY, GLENN AND STACEY MURPHY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH

22nd Season at ND | George Washington '82 | Career Record: 561-306 | ND Record: 462-254

In 22 seasons as the men's basketball coach at the University of Notre Dame, Mike Brey has guided the Fighting Irish to over 460 victories and is the all-time winningest men's basketball coach in school history.

The Irish are enjoying a recent stretch of success that ranks among the best in the 117-year history of basketball under the Golden Dome. Notre Dame was the only school in the nation to make back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Championship Elite Eight at the end of the 2015 and 2016 seasons, claimed an Atlantic Coast Conference title in 2015 and has made two ACC title game appearances in four years of ACC competition.

Brey was named head coach at Notre Dame on July 14, 2000. In his first season with the Irish, his team claimed the 2001 BIG EAST West Division championship and returned to the NCAA Championship for the first time in 12 seasons. Notre Dame soon became a regular in the NCAA tournament by making 12 appearances in 17 seasons with Brey on the sidelines.

In 2011, Brey was the recipient of both the Associated Press and the Henry Iba/USBWA National Coach of the Year award. He was named BIG EAST Coach of the Year in 2007, 2008 and 2011 and three of his players have been named BIG EAST Player of the Year.

Before arriving at Notre Dame, Brey was the head basketball coach at the University of Delaware, where he compiled a 99-52 mark from 1995-2000 and won America East Co-Coach of the Year honors in 1998. Prior to his time at Delaware, he was an assistant coach at Duke University. During his eight years at Duke, the Blue Devils advanced to the Final Four six times and won back-to-back national championships in 1991 and 1992.

Brey graduated from George Washington University in 1982. He played for and coached with legendary high school coach Morgan Wootten at DeMatha High School.
